

**Sh. Kundan Lal Ji
(1893-1966)**

Shri Kundan Lal Ji was passion personified. This Ludhiana born prodigy was a topper right from the beginning of his academic career. He was directly admitted to the Provincial Civil Services in 1915 and was appointed as a magistrate in Nagpur. His call of duty towards his motherland made him resign from the Civil Services in 1921. He became the 'Messiah' of the deprived section of the society. The foresightedness of this stalwart envisioned that good educational institutions are required to build a strong Indian who could stand on his own feet with conviction.

With this vision in mind, he started this great temple of learning Kundan Vidya Mandir in 1941, initially as a girls-only school. From humble beginnings, the school expanded to the present day Civil Lines and City Campus. In 1963 the school got the distinction of being the first school affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education from Punjab. Not only that, spreading its wings further, Kundan Vidya Mandir has set up its new branch named Kundan International School in 2007 at Chandigarh.

Having donated his entire property to a non-profit trust in 1950, Rai Sahib Shri Kundan Lal Ji became the personification of altruism. We strive to follow the ideals laid down by the founder of our school.



Introduction

Kundan Vidya Mandir is a Senior Secondary School affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, and is named after its founder a great visionary, Late Rai Sahib Kundan Lal Ji. The school was established in 1941 and is now one of the premier institutions of India.

The school takes pride in being the 1st school in Punjab to get affiliated to CBSE in 1963. A team of about 350 dedicated members of both teaching and non-teaching staff takes care of more than 5000 students. They deliver quality education and shape young minds. To transform our vision into reality, we have Mrs. Navita Puri, a talented and dynamic personality as the Principal of the school.

The main school is in Civil Lines. The students of the Civil Lines campus have been divided into four sections:

Kindergarten: LKG and UKG

Primary: Classes I to V

Middle: Classes VI to VIII

Senior: Classes IX to XI

To cater to the needs of the city clientele, we have another campus, in the heart of the city opposite the Railway Station. This campus is administered by the officiating Headmistress Mrs. Vinay Syal and the Principal Mrs. Navita Puri. The campus has two sections each of classes LKG to VIII, with a strength of about 900 students. After class VIII, the students of the City campus join class IX at the Civil Lines campus.

Keeping in mind the vision of the founder, in 2007 the Trust established Kundan International School in Sector 46, Chandigarh. This school is also affiliated to the CBSE and is administered by the Principal Mrs. Yogesh Jadli.



Aims & Objectives

The objective of the Managing Committee is to manage Kundan Vidya Mandir Senior Secondary School, Ludhiana, founded by SHRI KUNDAN LAL, in 1941 and to establish one or more of its branches, with the aim of developing among students:

- Habits, attitude and quality of character which will enable them to assume the responsibility of leadership in the social, political, cultural, industrial, economic and scientific fields, when they enter life.
- The capacity of clear thinking, clarity in speech and in writing, and a receptivity to new ideas.
- A spirit of discipline, cooperation, tolerance, self control, and courageous perseverance in the face of difficulties.
- Reverence for what is noble, i.e. to teach them to be ready to self sacrifice, to strive for utmost purity and truth, to foster in them a strong sense of duty and to instill in them that consideration and respect for others which



must be the foundation of selflessness, and the true basis of all good manners.

- Vocational efficiency i.e. students must acquire a yearning for perfection and learn to take pride in doing everything as thoroughly as they can, so that in future years their personal productive capacity in the economic fields be maximized.

Safety & Security

The safety and security of our students is of utmost importance at Kundan Vidya Mandir. Salient features of the safety measures followed here are:

- Police verification of all the teaching, non-teaching staff and helpers is done.
- 111 CCTV cameras are installed to keep an eye on every nook and corner of the campus.
- It is taken care that the junior and the senior wing students do not cross each other during the school hours.
- A child protection and safety committee has been formed.
- Three female security guards have been appointed who take vigilant rounds throughout the day.
- Separate washrooms for the students, support staff, teaching staff and the non teaching staff have been provided. However, teachers keep a constant vigil in these areas.
- An anti-sexual harassment committee has been formed.



Safety measures during Covid-19 Pandemic : To ensure safety and security of the students and the staff members, the following safety measures are being followed by heart and soul.

- Wearing mask
- Physical distancing
- Reinforcement of hand washing and sanitation.
- Sanitization of all the classes frequently.
- Vaccination of teaching and non-teaching staff.

The Primary Section provides an opportunity to every child to flourish in a healthy, safe and secure environment. We nurture our saplings with love and care so that these impressionable minds grow into shining diamonds and will one day be a jewel in the crown of abiding glory. We believe in experiential learning and learning by doing. Activity oriented teaching, Smart Class Programme, Circle Time Activities, French and Robotics Club, Assemblies and various other co-scholastic activities are conducted regularly with an aim of facilitating holistic learning, developing essential skills like concentration, decision making and making the child self-confident and independent.

3-D Science and Maths Labs help the students to learn the complex lessons in an easy way and develop their analytical skills. Edu Next helps the parents to know the activities done in the class.



HIGHER SECTION

In the Higher Section, we strive to create an environment which facilitates and enhances holistic development. Experience of learning along with experiential learning are our focus. Assessment here is an ongoing process and is done both formally and informally. Career Counselling is provided to each child individually so that his aptitude, attitude and interest are channelized towards the right direction. Community outreach is incorporated as our year round project. Robotics, Ignited Mind and Financial Literacy Programme are a part of this awareness drive. 'Sparkz' is a small private company created for, by and of the Commerce Department which provides a hands-on experience and creates an interest among students for business culture. The students are prepared for Board exams by highly qualified and trained staff. Skill subjects have been introduced. Excellence in scholastic and co-scholastic fields is aimed at. An experienced counsellor and a special needs teacher are a part of this faculty so that the finer details of personality and soft skills are honed and students are chiselled to turn out into real Kundans from Kundan Vidya Mandir.



MIDDLE SECTION

The Middle Section strives to encourage students to become increasingly self-directing, moving from dependent childhood to self-actuating adolescence. The universal values of truth, love, sharing, compassion and courtesy are ingrained in the very fabric of the curricular and co-curricular activities. The 'Readathons' of the 'The Readers Club' consider books as their best friends and are involved in encouraging their fellow students to read extra books. Life skills' training prepares the middle level students to deal effectively with the demands and challenges of everyday life. 3-D Science and Maths Labs help the students to understand the concepts in a better way through visualisation of the same. **'It is not what we tell them that matters, what we do when we are with them is what matters'** With this approach, the team of the Middle Section grooms the children into responsible future citizens of the nation. - Real Kundans



City Campus

The City Campus of Kundan Vidya Mandir which was founded by late Shri Kundan Lal Ji with just a few children in 1941 won so much acclaim that in 1956 another campus was set up in the Civil Lines area. The City Campus, that is the mother school, works in co-ordination with Kundan Vidya Mandir Civil Lines. The City Campus School is administrated by the officiating Headmistress Mrs. Vinay Syal and the Principal Mrs. Navita Puri. It has classes from LKG to VIII, with two sections for each class. After passing the VIII grade, the students shift to Kundan Vidya Mandir, Civil Lines for further education. Ideally located on the G.T. Road opposite the Railway Station, within a safe and secure environment, we seek to equip our pupils for the world of today and tomorrow, to foster self-esteem and respect for others to widen the horizons and to give them the means to reach those horizons and beyond.

Counselling Services

Counselling has the power to impact budding and young minds, who are in their journey of finding themselves. One of the most important determinants in teaching and learning is trust and a belief that each child is capable of unlocking his/her potential and this can be built by human connections and communication. It is for this reason that the school has four counsellors to address the emotional, social and behavioural needs of the students. Regular Career Counselling sessions are organised for the benefit of the students. One period in a week is allotted to each class as a 'Life Skills' period. Emphasis is also laid on developing confidence and ensuring the mental well being of the learners. Updates and detailed reports are sent to the parents on regular basis. Also, a personal mentor for a small group of students for classes V, VIII and XII has been allotted to take care of these children regarding their emotional needs.







Admission Rules for Online Registration

Admission to LKG

Age Eligibility: Born between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018.

Registration Date: As notified

Birth Certificate: Original Birth Certificate of the selected candidate will be retained by the school at the time of depositing fees and it will not be returned.

Family Photograph: A latest family photograph of father, mother and the ward to be uploaded at the time of registration. Please note that registration makes a child eligible for consideration for admission only; it does not guarantee admission. Incomplete forms will be rejected.

Note: The fees and other charges once deposited will not be refunded.

Admission to Class XI

Admission will be purely on the basis of the performance in class X as well as on the aptitude of the student.

For students who have passed from other schools or other boards, the discretion for admission rests with the Principal subject to availability of seats.

Transfer Certificate : Students migrating from the other schools must submit their Transfer and Migration Certificate and Progress Reports from their previous school.

Examination

1. There will be continuous and comprehensive evaluation of the performance of students in the Kindergarten Section during the session. Only grades will be reflected in the report cards.
2. As per CBSE direction, special scheme of assessment for the session 2021-22 has been introduced. Academic Session has been divided into two terms with rationalized syllabus.
3. According to the Special Assessment Structure, two terms (Term-I and Term-II) have been earmarked for internal assessment (10+10) in each subject and (40+40) marks for the final examination.
4. Weightage for class XI will be 20% to 1st Term, 20% to 2nd Term and 60% to the Annual Examination.
5. There is no re-scheduling of exam for any student. Students absenting themselves from an examination for any reason other than illness, will be considered fail. In case of illness, a valid Medical Certificate from a qualified doctor will have to be produced.
6. A student absenting himself/herself from an examination will be fined Rs. 200/- per paper.

Note:

1. Date of birth once registered and spellings of the name of student and parents on the form will not be altered later.
2. Due consideration for admission will be given to the children of EWS families as per the provisions of the RTE Act.

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Note

- Fee will be accepted only by online mode through 'Edunext' app of school.
- Fee for April to June is to be deposited in the month of April, for July to Sept. in the month of July, for Oct. to Dec. in the month of October, for January to March in the month of January.

Note:

- Re-admission if granted, will be done on payment of ₹500/-
- Students coming from unrecognised schools will have to pay fees for the whole session, no matter when they join.

Withdrawal:

A parent who wishes to withdraw his/her ward must apply for the same before the month ends, else the fee for the next month will be charged.

Note:

- Laboratory/Practicals Fee of ₹100/- per month per subject will be realised from the students of Class XI and Class XII viz. Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Geography. Students opting for Home Science will pay a fee of ₹135/- per month. Shooting Fee will be ₹300/- per month.
- Library Security and Admission Security will be refunded at the time of leaving the school. If the security is not claimed within six months of the child's leaving the school, it will be forfeited.
- The management reserves the right to review the fee structure and other charges, during the session.
- School charges once paid are not refundable, except advance fee which includes Tuition Fee, Amalgamated Fund and Science Fee.
