Colourful Classrooms – The comfortable, clean and well ventilated classrooms create exactly the right kind of atmosphere for learning to take place. All classrooms are equipped with Smart boards. We do not encourage fixed seating pattern which makes the class room teaching even more innovative. A book bank and loads of teaching aids add to the attraction of each classroom.









Play Area – Gross motor development aptly takes place when the children are engaged in free play & structured play. A colourful and child friendly play station outdoors, welcomes children with open arms to have full fun time whereas a special area is designated for structured play where the children learn to play in a team, accept challenges & defeat. Every Wednesday the students are engaged in mass PT drill. Every day before the children start their daily chores they practice deep breathing which helps them keep their minds fresh and alert.







Music & Movement – The Music & Dance room is a place most loved by kids. Here they enjoy their music & movement sessions as these help in creating a rhythm in their little bodies and also strengthen their motor skills.







Activity Room, as the name suggests, is a hub of activities. A variety of well planned activities and competitions round the year help in developing their various skills. Their imagination, conceptualization, inquisitiveness, self expression and creativity are stimulated through clay moulding, colllage making, tower building, jigsaw puzzles etc. A small wooden stage gives an opportunity to each and every Bhavanite to get involved in either group activity or solo performance.









Medical Room – A well equipped medical room with a trained nurse and first aid facilities takes care of emergencies. Regular height and weight of the child is also monitored.









Swimming Pool – Balwadi Toddlers visit the toddler's pool on the splashing day and after they enter the first standard then the International size swimming pool awaits them.






